

## Rally Bohemia 2010 - Basic information:

### FIA European Rally Cup – Region Central (coefficient 10) Mediasport International Rally Championship of the Czech Republic Platinum Car Rally Championship of Poland

Rally Bohemia is the car racing competition well-known for its challenging special stages not only in the Czech Republic but also abroad. This rally has a long tradition, which will carry on in July with its 37<sup>th</sup> anniversary. Yet again it is credited by FIA European Rally Cup with coefficient 10, by Mediasport International Rally Championship of the Czech Republic and also by very attractive Polish Championship. The Autoklub Bohemia Sport in AČR is the organizer and Škoda Auto Company is the main partner. Among those very prestigious partners belong the city of Mladá Boleslav, Middle Bohemia and Liberec region. The headquarters, start and finish are situated to the city of cars, Mladá Boleslav.

The 37<sup>th</sup> anniversary will take place in two legs with almost same long, difficult and very technical special stages on the asphalt surface. The spectator's introductory super special stage in Sosnová will start on Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> July. The first leg starts on Saturday in the morning and among others it will also contain the city special stage in the streets of Mladá Boleslav and Vinec, but this time in reverse direction. Sunday's leg will be laced with the most difficult special stage in the Czech Republic, no less legendary Návarov. The most successful competing crew is expected to finish at around 5.40pm on the Central Stadium in Mladá Boleslav. After 14 years the organizers have decided to change the location to the stadium also for the Headquarters and Press Centre.

Event of the year is also the comeback of Autoklub Škoda among the collaborating organizers. Central service zone can be found in the area of the 11<sup>th</sup> gate of the Škoda Auto factory. Total length of the whole competition is 754 kms, from which 16 special stages represent 227 cutting-edge kilometres. Only the cars suitable to the FIA regulations appendix "J" will be accepted into the competition together with valid homologation of "A" or "N" category.
