

RALLY BOHEMIA 2010 - Basic safety notes

Should you decide to watch any of the special stages, you have to realize that you do it only at your own risk. Above all it is in your own interest to strictly follow instructions mentioned below:

ALWAYS

- get to know all the spectator's tips. Conform your special stage selection, accessing roads and parking places to them.
- choose only such spots, which are designated by the organizers to be organized spectator's places.
- park your vehicle on designated park places and lay-bay areas, which are marked by the organizers.
- be aware of the time limits, which are before and after the special stage and during which the special stage is closed.
- preoccupy your chosen spot in advance before the first competitive crew goes through.
- follow organizer's instructions, when you are asked to leave the area where you are.
- keep at safe distance from the road. There is no physical law by which racing car wouldn't end up in the place where you are standing. You must realize that racing cars go very fast. Technical fault or fault of the driver can never be eliminated.
- conform to bright judgment and good behaviour. Imagine yourselves in the organizer's shoes. Help by being an example to others.
- wait for the passage of opening car. Until this moment the route is still closed and there is high possibility that some late competition crew suddenly appears. The opening car carries white flag. So don't you worry, you will recognize it.
- be predictive, expect unexpected.
- look after yourself, your close ones and other spectators around you. Be an organizer to yourselves.

NEVER

- try to drive on the route of special stage.
- park at the place being an obstacle to crews, support cars, organizer cars, fire brigade vehicles and ambulance cars.
- try to enter the area marked as DO NOT ENTER!
- sit down while watching rally unless you are several meters above the route level!
- keep your hands in your pockets unless you are several meters above the route level!
- turn your back to driving thru cars, keep an eye contact on them!
- stay below the level of the route!
- stay in front of the solid obstacles while watching rally (fence, wall, rock, house, etc.). Think of possible leaving your spot quickly!
- trust the media writing about the protective security tape. It's a non sense, there is no such a thing.
- never believe the deception that you can't get hurt. It's a big mistake. Rally sport can be very dangerous.
- run cross the route of special stage. Only when it is really very necessary, remember that the time intervals between the racing cars are mostly around 1 minute. Relatively low risk lasts only 40 seconds (you have to take into account the different driving abilities of the competition crews and the distance between you and the start line).
- throw anything onto the route! You could jeopardise the safety of competition crews. Such behaviour is covered by law.
- let you children off your sight. You are fully responsible for their safety. Never put them in front of you for a better view.
- take you pets with you. They don't belong to rally. Make sure, that you pets are securely off the route.
- cover the signposts, labels, direction signs and other equipment or driving aids by you standing in front of it.
- copy the competition crews while on the ordinary road.
